■ History of the International Conference on Equine Exercise Physiology ■

The First International Conference on Equine Exercise Physiology was held in Oxford, England in September 1982. The purpose was to bring together scientists who were actively studying the physiology of the exercising horse. It was decided in Oxford that there should be subsequent meetings every four years to allow various investigators to meet again, to share results from recent work, and to develop collaborative relationships. An International Committee of distinguished scientists was formed to oversee the continuation of the inaugural meeting. Since 1982, quadrennial meetings have been held in California (1986), Sweden (1990), Australia (1994), Japan (1998) and Kentucky (2002).

■ Location of the conference: Fontainebleau

Fontainebleau is a famous place in the forest where the kings stayed for hunting and holidays. Fontainebleau is located in the middle of a national park where walking, riding and climbing are often undertaken.

This is a lovely tourist area with many castles, villages with impressionist paintings (Barbizon, Moret-sur-Loing, Château de By), the Disneyland Paris park, and it is close to Paris.



Fontainebleau and the surrounding area are well known for equestrian sport activities. During the ICEEP 7 meeting, the National Show Jumping Championship "La Grande Semaine de l'Élevage" will take place for 10 days in Fontainebleau at the Grand Parquet horse park.

Congress venue:

ICEEP 7 will be held in an old Italian style but recently renovated conference room downtown. Lunch will be served in the hall.

The town of Fontainebleau is located 50 km south of Paris in France (Europe). You can reach Fontainebleau by car or train. The two nearest (1 hour or less) international airports are:

• Tour 1 (64 €)

Guided tour of the Château de Fontainebleau (morning) + lunch + painter's village of Moret-sur-Loing (afternoon): at the heart of the ling forest, the château invites you to a surprising walk throughout centuries. From François Ier to Napoleon III, it was the hunting rendez-vous of the greatest French kings. In the footsteps of the famous impressionist painter Alfred SISLEY, who painted about 400 pictures of Moret and the Loing, you will be charmed by the romantic and picturesque architecture of this medieval city.



• Tour 2 (69 €)

Guided tour of the Auberge Ganne museum in Barbizon, painter's village (morning) + lunch + guided tour of the royal-tennis court + the Military equestrian centre of Fontainebleau (afternoon). The Ganne Inn is one of the most exceptional ways to discover how the landscape painters in the XIXe century were attracted by Barbizon. Paintings on the walls and the furniture of the Ganne couple, everything served as a means of expression for these young artists...



• **Tour 3 (77 €)**

Guided visit of the Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte + lunch + the Seine river cruise.

Three great artists in French art history made this château, the masterpiece of the XVIIIth century: Le Brun, Le Vau and Le Nôtre. It later served as a model for the building of Versailles.



• **Tour 4 (66 €)**

Guided tour of Provins + the “Eagles of the ramparts” + guided tour of the “Tith barn”. The European capital of trade fairs during the Middle Ages, Provins is historical and protected testimony of medieval life. Due to its extraordinary heritage, UNESCO has classified Provins as part of world heritage.

From the Caesar’s Tower to the church of Saint Quiriace, from the ramparts to the underground passageways, the medieval city bears exceptional witness to its past.



• **Tour 5 (79 €)**

Paris Sightseeing bus tour + lunch + cruise in Paris + panoramic view of Paris from the Eiffel Tower.

This tour will give you the opportunity to discover the main monuments of Paris and its history: Opera Square, Champs-Élysées, Arc-de-Triomphe, Invalides ...with a guide.

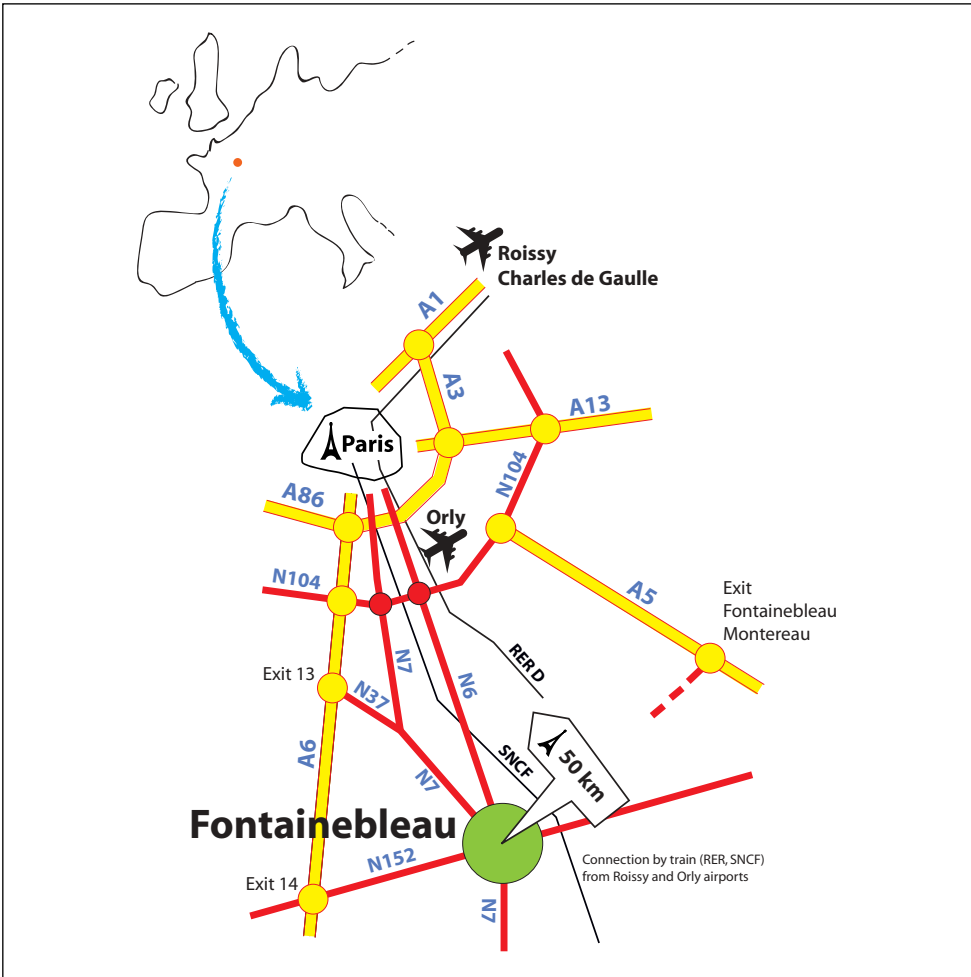
